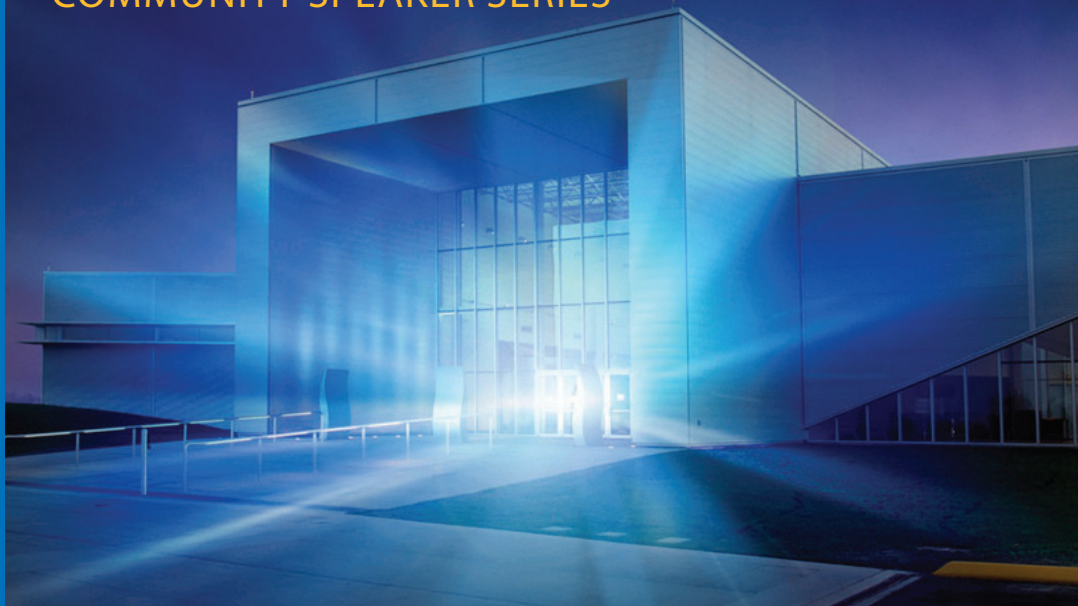

JOE JUSTICE, CEO WIKISPEED

Joe Justice is a Seattle-area agile business process consultant and entrepreneur, and a registered automotive manufacturer since 2007. In 2010, Joe's X Prize team, WIKISPEED, used agile process to tie for 10th place in the mainstream class of the Progressive Insurance Automotive X Prize, a \$10 million challenge for 100+ MPGe automobiles. WIKISPEED now uses agile, lean, and scrum to deliver hyper-efficient customer cars and rapidly solve problems for social good.

Joe has spoken on social web application development, project methodology, manufacturer process, and agile best practices to audiences at Denver University, University of California Berkeley, Google, The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, Rotary International, and others. Joe is a nominated TEDx speaker and a co-author of Scrumban2 and Microsoft Project Server 2010 for Professionals. Joe is currently a consultant at SolutionsIQ and CEO of WIKISPEED.
